I am writing to object to the proposed access for the proposed houses on the A58, on the site of the Westfield Pub. (I have no objection to the houses, but the proposed access is of great concern)The proposed access comes into a very busy junction, directly on top of the traffic lights, that are timed very much in favour with the main A58. There is also an exit road from the garage opposite, which is directly opposite the proposed exit onto Westfield Lane. At the back of the site there is the Kirklees/Bradford boundary and Greenacre Way. Would it be safer and more practical to use Greenacre as a way to access the site?

I understand that this is on the site of an old pub, but to be fair many customers did not take their car to the pub, and the access times were very different, not at peak times. As far as I can see we are going to have cars leaving and returning at peak traffic times, putting extra stress on what is a very busy and dangerous junction.
