During that time I was involved in several of the previous attempts to seek planning permission for this plot of land. When we all first moved into April court the builder had an obligation to landscape that piece of land together with the piece of land as you enter April court. The objections I raised before still stand. ie 1. Parking is limited for the residents already living on April Court. If a house was built on the proposed site we would lose the turning circle and/or the parking adjacent. 2. On a previous objection the council planning committee came in a single decker bus. They struggled to turn the bus and reverse back out, and that is before 2 more houses are built. 3. This also highlighted a problem with potential emergency vehicles such as fire engine. 4. During the proposed building of the properties, access would be very difficult for residents because of construction vehicles, not to mention the noise and mud. 5. The reason previous planning has been denied still stands. It is not the size, shape, windows etc of the proposed property but access and the disruption it would cause. Leeds road is a very busy road and with more houses being built it will only get worse.
