

**Consultation Response from KC,

Barn Lee is a Grade II listed barn conversion dating back to 1674 in a rural setting within a small settlement.

The applicant proposes to erect 1.2m high wire and post sheep fencing and wooden gates to form a perimeter around the garden. Part of the boundary already has dry stone walling. A large 5 bar timber gate is proposed across the driveway, along with 2 smaller pedestrian 5 bar gates at the top and bottom of the drive, mounted on 20cm x 20cm wooden posts.

I consider this proposal to be entirely in keeping with the character of this former farm building and its rural setting as this type of boundary feature is typical of field boundaries in this area. I have no objections to this proposal.
