Traffic. This is already bad around this junction. During rush hour the tailbacks can reach from halfway down Centurion Way to Owl Lane main roundabout and the same in the opposite direction. Leeds Road tails back to Woodkirk Valley most nights and past the Co-op in the other direction. Turning right from Leeds Road onto Owl Lane lets 3 or 4 cars through, adding to this will likely gridlock Shaw Cross several times a day. Rubbish. The quieter surrounding streets will be subject to huge amounts of rubbish, as is the case around other McDonalds that have small car parks.
