Dear Ms Huxley,

A neighbour has just made me aware of planning application 2020/62/90594/W relating to Lock 22 café, 39 Bridge Street, Slaithwaite.

the first I have heard of this application.

the application did not appear on local search dated 27 Feb 2020. According to the council website, the application was received on 25 Feb 2020.

not notified of the application either.

I have not seen any notices put up locally, as usually happens with planning applications.

My main concern is that the premises should remain as a café and not be used as a bar in the evening.

I note the response from Hannah Kent of the council's Environmental Health department, saying that her department has no objections providing "The premises shall not be open outside the hours of 08.30 to 18.00 Monday to Saturday and 09.30 to 16.00 on Sunday".

I have no problem with the application if these are to be the opening hours but would object if Environmental Health's recommendations to restrict the opening hours are overruled.

I have a disability that would make it hard for me to cope with drunk people stumbling out of a bar late at night. I am concerned that they may try to urinate in my front or back yard, or worse still, fall into the canal and drown because this side of the canal only has railings between the café and the main road, not outside my house. I am not physically capable of pulling a drunk person out of the canal.
