Dear Planning Department

I have very serious and worrying concerns over the proposed extension.

Then there is the matter of **personal safety** – there is a wall between no 70 and the house above – no 72. The proposed double side extension provides for only a very, very narrow and long ‘tunnel’ access. Therefore, as well as the previous reasons, there is a safety aspect - if someone were to be attacked, there would be no room to fight or escape and they would not be seen from the street.

I feel very strongly that a **site visit** would be appropriate, and am formally requesting this now, so you can see for yourselves the massive detrimental impact the proposed

extension would have _____ and how it would significantly affect normal household routines, provide stresses when work is required _____ as well as the safety issue.

With the corona virus taking over everyone's life at the moment and social distancing a must, I am officially requesting the application be put back until after this pandemic is over, to allow time to arrange a site visit and engagement of a solicitor.
