The extension will look very out of place and ugly, with it being in a conservation area and a historic building any extension should be more in keeping with the style of the building and area. The application also mentions the building being used to 'socialise' and entertain clients as part of a business members club, I'm concerned about the level of noise and unsociable hours, as the plans show that there is no internal access to the orangery and all access is via the courtyard outside. I am also worried about the amount of available parking on the street. There is limited availability currently for residents, using the land for an extension and not for more parking would mean that this would increase in cars, traffic and noise on an already busy and space limited road.
