Hello Stuart,

We still have a few concerns regarding the application that haven't been addressed yet we're mentioned in the application decision

In section 4- it's states that there should 'minimise impact on neighbours' however you've approved a building too close to our boundary wall and we now have no where or way to access our back wall for repairs. The gap is cm's away in places which means that debris from the trees etc and water is able to get through and there is no drainage, this will impact our property.

In section 7 representations - it clearly states that a nearby residential property was re-consulted, of this is referencing number 13 we can confirm that no consultation from the applicant ever took place and non of our concerns or requests were taken into consideration. Can I request this is either amended from the planning application as this is no a reflection of events or we are consulted properly, directly in writing as there has been no party wall agreement or attempt to address our concerns.

The current owners started building before planning was granted so we feel very much rail roaded and completely ignored. Please can you confirm the next steps to address the issues I've highlighted.
