Type of comment: An objection
The proposed address is on the main Wakefield road, which has double yellow lines on either side . Outside the proposed address is a crossing used by children going to Manor Croft Academy one way and young children going to Earlsheaton infants the other way. It has 2 road junctions at either side of the proposed address which are residential with very little off road parking space for residents as is, with many of these houses designated for the vulnerable and disabled who may need access in an emergency and it is also very difficult to see properly to get out on to wakefield road already without increased volume of cars parked and increased traffic. This can also be made more difficult by traffic coming in and out of the Tesco garage and medical center 50 meters further down the road. There are also bus stops on either side of Wakefield road inbetween the crossing and medical center on one side and inbetween the Tesco garage and crossing on the otherside which could makes it more difficult and dangerous for pedestrians if the road were any busier or with increased number of parked vehicles. The biggest concern is for the safety of local residents and those attending schools in an ready high risk environment.
