The nearest one is in Eastborough and its only a short walk from the place where the applicant wants to put a new one. I do not feel there is a need for another one in the area and so close to another mosque. The traffic on Wakefield Road is very busy on a daily basis, its a bus route and an ambulance route and they are up and down all day, if people start parking where they shouldnt be and blocking roads this could have a negative affect on the patient's in the ambulance or even police and fire service going about there daily buisness. There is nowhere to park around the proposed site, it is a residential area as is old bank road, the cars are parked on both sides and no room for anymore. It was eveident about how bad the tradfic can be when all the works from the fiber company was done and it was a one way system, the queues on a daily basis was horrific. There is no room for any more cars to be parked in the area, there are no spaces left. The applicant says it will be for pedestrian members only this i believe will not happen and as soon as other worshippers find out there is a mosque nearer to them they will drive, they will call in on their way home from work in their cars. I do hope that you listen to peoples genuine concerns over why they do not want this to go ahead this is about safety of everyone who uses wakefield road either by vehicle, cycling or walking.
