I object to the developers plans to remove and significantly lop back (top the point of destroying?) mature trees identified T5/B2 and T6/C2 shown on the eastern boundary to the field. The trees have significant positive visual appeal and been in existence for many years. Root structure will assist with the well documented flooding problems in adjacent (and within boundary) of existing properties. The trees help support wildlife; bats and various bird life, inc. birds of prey. Partridge have also been seen in the field. The previous owner, who was a keen bird watcher, when I asked him, said that partridge were a legacy from the Saville Estate days. It is good that the trees are being retained along the western boundary of the field. I request that same consideration is given to the tress on the eastern boundary.
