<p>In addition to my previous comments I would like to add quotes from the East Bierley Conservation area appraisal "The open space in the conservation area consists of small and large private gardens, The Green and Bierley Marsh. Too much infill development and extensive housing developments in East Bierley will have a serious effect on the character of the conservation area. Loss of boundary walls, high loss of trees and open space or if there is an increase in building density it may be harmful to the character and be detrimental to the conservation area." It would be seriously detrimental to the Village if any more of Bierley Marsh is lost - either to a highway or as a car park. Once green areas are lost they are lost forever. It is highly ironic that a flag pole flying a Green Flag award is situated in the centre of Bierley Marsh.
