We comment as follows. Firstly we understand that an application for multiple properties mas made previously and refused. The applicant has built the one house permitted. Nothing has changed to make a further application more acceptable. Our main objection is of serious and prolonged danger to children The entrance/exit is extremely narrow and on a stretch of road with no pavement at either side. It is however heavily used by young children, with and without their parents/carers as they make their way to and from school. We have personally experienced the danger of this section of Common End Lane taking our children to school for over 10 years, and the last thing this section of narrow road needs is construction vehicles during construction and additional traffic entering and exiting the site after construction. There are also secondary matters. This application would appear to be for a house out of keeping with other houses in the area. The area of Jumble wood is a rare wild space in the area where we personally have seen deer, badgers and heard woodpeckers. The plans appear to show the destruction of mature broadleaf trees. The construction of the proposed dwelling would appear to endanger wildlife. The construction of the previous house caused much inconvenience, road closures and noise.
