Type of comment: A general comment
Our principal comment is one concerning safety of pedestrians, and in particular of children accompanied and unaccompanied. The entrance/exit to the proposed site has not be improved after the previous build and we can see no reference to improving it in the current application. The entrance/exit is on a narrow lane which has no pavement on either side. The lane is in daily heavy use by children going to and from school and is dangerous. We have had personal experience of the danger having taken our children to and from school over many years. The problem is twofold. Construction vehicles will cause this danger to children to be significantly increased during construction as they will park on this narrow lane, as they have and continue to do in the present construction. If it went ahead the increased traffic in and out of the hidden entrance/exit would represent an ongoing risk to the safety of children and adults passing. This is in addition to the noise and disturbance which will be caused. The present ongoing work has already represented a significant nuisance. Additionally, the plans show a house out of keeping with other houses in the area. They also show a construction in an area which is in one of the only areas of real natural beauty in the area. Jumble wood is full of wild life. We personally have seen deer and badgers there and heard woodpeckers there. The proximity of the proposed construction could not fail to damage this wildlife
