Whilst I appreciate the heritage of the area and the need to conserve and preserve local history, the wall in question (which serves little to no purpose) was built at a time and a place - and is no longer suitable or appropriate for modern living. The part demolition of the wall, maintaining the original stone and simply moving it further down (still keeping part of the existing wall), in my view, would not ruin any aesthetics of the area but instead make living here more attractive to prospective residents and something which should be supported.
