

Subject: Planning application 2020/62/91978/W Town Head

Hi Charles,

Hope you and the family are well.

You are perhaps aware of the planning application to remove part of a drystone wall on Town Head, Honley.

The background is that the owner, who does not live in the village, rents the property on a full time basis and is trying to boost its rental potential by removing the wall to create access to what would be a parking space in front of the property.

The Main argument, supported by the majority of local residents, is around the conservation of the wall, street and local area for which I am an ardent supporter and have lodged my objection.

On another side of the debate and the reason for this email. Whilst out walking this morning I took the attached picture of some of the residents dustbins neatly lined up against the wall which is the subject of part demolition. Awaiting collection are 9 bins from 9 households, no one argues, no one objects, no ones space is compromised. The bins can't be moved further along the wall as the street narrows and cars would not be able to pass, so if the wall goes the bins would have to take up residence in valuable parking spaces.

I know that the planning application is being managed by Ellie Worth but was wondering if you could forward this on to her providing it's not bypassing the process of course.
