<p>After looking at the plans I am extremely concerned about the damage to existing trees & wildlife. I can see from the plans it looks like that the existing trees which are now situated along the school boundary wall that back onto the back of the houses on Malvern Rise are proposed to no longer be there.</p> <p>The removal of these trees not only has implications on the environment but the existing houses that are situated on Malvern Rise will without question have an increase in loss of privacy & most certainly an Increase in noise due to where the houses are situated & with the removal of the existing trees (due to the fact that the proposed properties will be on the same level as them)</p> <p>I feel should the trees be kept In place it will most certainly help with these factors & it goes without saying & more importantly we should be doing everything we can to help protect our wildlife & birds natural habitat and we are surrounded by lots in the area. Foxes and bats are often seen at night & I believe one of our neighbours is visited regularly by a badger.</p> <p>I am also concerned about an increase in traffic. We already have a problem with limited parking on such a small road, with students (term time) & taxis parking here everyday which leaves very little space & consequently then there's not enough space for resident to park.</p> <p>For example where are the family & friends from the 30 homes parking if they visit ? If each new home owner owns 2 cars that's potentially an extra 60 cars minimum (without visitors) coming & going each day. I do not feel that the plane street or Malvern Rise, being a cul-de-sac can accommodate the increase in the extra traffic.</p>
