<p>Having read through the comments section objecting to this proposal I can see my concerns (negative impact on local infrastructure, flora and fauna) have been raised by numerous other people.</p> <p>I walk in the area impacted on a daily basis. Around the fields, along the waterways and through the woods. Over the past year I have seen deer, hares, owls, hawks, kingfishers and have used applications to identify birdsong which has listed numerous birds both native and migratory. My concerns in this area is the loss of and disturbance of the habitats of these species and once lost they will be gone forever from this area. There are news features and dedicated TV programmes positively supporting re-wilding projects across Britain and it seems counterproductive to these aims to plan for developments such as this one that will negatively impact our own local wildlife.</p> <p>The A653 is already very busy and, feedback from a local councillor, the junction at John Ormsby VC Way and Leeds Road is one of the busiest in Kirklees already and there seems to have been an increase in traffic on Owl lane following the recent Barrett development. The negative increase in traffic as a result of the proposed development can only serve to further increase traffic and pollution on the local residential areas.</p>
