<p>My objection is based on the following grounds:</p> <p>Food security is essential for ensuring all individuals have access to sufficient, safe and nutritious food which leads to improved health, economic stability and social equity.</p> <p>In such an unstable world it is vital that as a country we are able to provide food for the population. You only have to look at what has happened with gas and electricity and how countries have become dependent on countries such as Russia. By using agricultural land to build houses and business on you are slowly eroding the countries ability to provide security.</p> <p>My other objection is based on the effect that such a huge development will have on the people who already live there . This will transform an area that has already experienced extensive housebuilding in the last decade with the Amberwood Chase development and the houses currently being built on Owl lane. You are proposing to add a further 1500 hundred homes a minimum of an additional 3,000 people (based on each new house to house a minimum of two people) plus a business development with increased traffic and people. This will have a huge impact on the environment increasing pollution but also impacting the mental health of the local residents by transforming their way of life You will have managed to remove virtually all green space from the area.</p>
