<p>I wish to object to this development on the following grounds:</p> <p>The development is contrary to the Government's National Planning Policy Framework which supports health, social and cultural wellbeing.</p> <p>This will create threats to the health of children and adults from pollution due to thousands of extra vehicles using the A653, traffic will be affected across all three local authorities due to the sprawl and sheer size of this development. Local schools are already operating at capacity with no plans by Kirklees to build new schools. The industrial section of this development will mean a high volume of heavy goods traffic, affecting all feeder roads between the motorways and the developoment.</p> <p>The land acts as a zero carbon emission "green lung" separating Kirklees, Wakefield and Leeds - building on Chidswell will create massive urban sprawl with communities losing their identity. I live on the West Ardsley side of this piece of green belt land. It's a much loved and much valued green space for residents of all three local authorities that it touches.</p> <p>Doctors' surgeries and public amenities would be unable to cope with such a rise in population, most already operate at full capacity. Roads are already busy and will not be able to absorb the extra traffic. Public transport is less than ideal.</p>
