<p>I would like to object to this development, as a resident of the local area I know that this will put a massive strain on a presently over used A653. The highway infrastructure cannot accommodate any more vehicles, some nights I am queuing for between 30 mins to 45 mins just to get down Leeds Road to Shaw cross, also the air quality will be dramatically affected leading to health risks from pollution due to thousands of extra vehicles using the A653 and the noise for the Leeds Road occupants will be affected immensely due to more vehicles sat in idle whilst queuing. This amount of dwellings will put a strain on the local amenities Doctors/Dentists/Nurseries,Primary,Junior & High schools all already over subscribed in the area leading to a drop in standards at the local schools and not to mention the destruction to the countryside and its inhabitants.Local residents use these areas for family activities/recreation i.e walking, cycle paths picnics. There is not enough recreational areas within easy reach without having to get in the car and drive to, also the land acts as a zero carbon emission "green lung" separating Kirklees, Wakefield and Leeds - building on Chidswell will create massive urban sprawl with communities losing their identity . I am saddened to see the potential of such a massive development which will alter the character of the area beyond recognition and change the beautiful landscape forever. Finally the development is contrary to the Government's National Planning Policy Framework which supports health, social and cultural wellbeing. I seriously hope that Kirklees council planning department think long and hard regarding this application and do what is right for the residents that already live in this area, rather than what they think is best for the area that they do not have to live in.</p>
