<p>I am a resident on Leeds Road and I have lived on the road my entire life. Currently the volume of traffic in the area where the proposed planning site is located is ridiculous and to add more volumes of traffic and to increase traffic the population to the area would cause a lot of tension on the current resources such as health centres, hospitals and high schools.</p> <p>As the last application was unsuccessful due to public objection and building on green belt. I ask why should it be possible to try again when everyone in the local area and also surrounding areas object to the plans?</p> <p>As many people like myself suffer with asthma, I have found that in recent years the more traffic that has generated in this area, the worse that the air quality has become. Not to mention the dust that is already kicked up in the air in the area from the nearby Quarry.</p> <p>Adding more traffic would only cause more harmful emissions to be put into the air causing irreversible harm to nearby wildlife and it would also have a detrimental effect on the health of the thousands of residents in the area.</p> <p>The current noise pollution in the entirety of the area is absurd, I lay awake until early hours of the morning because of the noises of motorists and traffic (bearing in mind my bedroom is to the back of the house facing fields with double-glazed windows).</p> <p>Building any sort of industrial, commercial or residential estate on the proposed area would depreciate the beauty of the woods around the proposed area and the wildlife that resides in it. It is a beauty spot and is a lovely wildlife walk.</p> <p>For years, the U.K. government and local councils have attempted to become more 'green'. However, if you propose to build on an area that is beneficial to the wildlife that populate the area and also risk noise and air pollution that could increase health problems of the existing residents in the area that isn't beneficiary to the economy or environment from a residents perspective as the more money spent that is spent on healthcare for residents and road maintenance upkeep for the amount heavy traffic doesn't seem to justify the 'need' for the proposed plans</p>

It seems that the cons outweigh the pro's for this proposed application.

The current residents do not want to view industrial estates from their homes and there will be no privacy for residents due to traffic and other buildings viewing the residents properties on a daily basis. Sunlight to properties will be disturbed meaning there will be less greenery.
