Especially in our area of West Yorkshire greenfield sites and open spaces are receding at a rapid rate, changing the landscape for the worse. As well as causing disruption to the wildlife, the construction will disrupt local residents' lives for years, as well as putting strain on existing public infrastructure. E.g.
