<p>Building houses here will significantly increase all traffic numbers around the local area, it will increase air and noise pollution. I notice there is equipment in place to measure traffic numbers and air quality, this information will be meaningless to use in the decision making process for two reasons, it's school holidays so less traffic anyway and as a result of the continuing lockdown in Kirklees and the general impact of the pandemic it is significantly reducing traffic movement which will not continue when all restrictions are lifted and later when homeworkers return to work and more face to face interactions take place. I have seen my travel time to work double in the last 10 years as result of the existing new housing developments. During rush hour you can queue from M1 roundabout to Owl lane and Shaw Cross for 20 plus minutes. All routes to both major motorways M1, M62, routes to Huddersfield on A644 and to Wakefield A638 and A653 to Leeds are currently incredibly busy, all local commuters drive through or around this area and it is currently not fit for purpose so to build even more houses is ludicrous and thoughtless for the environment.</p> <p>Also this one of the very few areas of local woodland in North Kirklees and helps people to exercise which helps with health and mental wellbeing, areas which the Council are keen to promote so to loose them would have a massive negative impact on North Kirklees residents.</p>
