<p>My objections are the following</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. There are plenty of brown field areas to build on within Kirklees without building on working farmland.2. The volume of traffic is already heavy on Leeds Rd but will get even worse once schools and workers are back to normal after COVID-19 subsides, so will get worse with the proposed housing and industrial estates. Also having a further 2 proposed traffic lights which will make 4 lots in a short area of the Rd.3. Surrounding schools won't be able to cope with the amount of children especially if Covid is long term and schools have to change how they operate.4. Since Covid more people are exercising outside and have being using the footpaths in the fields which is also improving mental health without having to drive to actually get out into the country.5.The wildlife in the fields will be lost.6. Traffic pollution on Leeds Road will get worse due to standing traffic at all the traffic lights.7.
