<p>The roads around the planned site are already severely congested at peak times and the addition of 1,354 dwellings (most often with a minimum of 2 vehicles) and associated businesses listed in the application will simply bring the area to a standstill whilst significantly raising pollution levels to well in excess of the government targets.</p> <p>We are already struggling to get access to doctors surgeries with appointments often over a month out and again this development will strangle the already overburdened services. The frequency of our refuse collection is terrible and we can often be left with the same waste in our black bins for 4 weeks which has an environmental impact and will only get worse with the increase in properties. There has been a significant amount of crime brought into the area following the development at Amberwood Chase. I was one of those impacted when my home was burgled 2 years ago by the same youths who immediately targeted one of those properties after I disturbed them in my kitchen. The police couldn't capture the thieves and there is zero police presence anywhere within my immediate vicinity. A local business owner rang the police a 4am one morning this week to report that 4 masked men were trying to break into his business only to be told that no-one from the police could come out and could he deal with it himself. Do the council really want to allow more and more of the electorate to be targeted and suffer the loss of often irreplaceable valuables as well as the emotional distress of having their home violated without the necessary police protection in the interest of greed ? That's exactly what will happen if this application is granted.</p> <p>Finally the loss of the open countryside and associated wildlife will be a devastating blow to the hundreds of people who enjoy it. Not only will it be lost forever but will be replaced with years of high polluting diesel construction vehicles and the associated transportation of materials vehicles it will require.</p> <p>I firmly believe granting this application will be one of the worst decisions the council could make and will have a devastating impact on the large community who unanimously do not want it here. Ever</p>
