<p>As a District Councillor for the neighbouring ward of Ossett, I wish to object to this application as follows:</p> <p>This will increase the amount of traffic on the roads of my ward, this is already backed up on the way to the Owl Lane roundabout, this development, if the application is passed, will make matters considerably worse. Wakefield MDC have a climate change target and this will affect that target with the additional vehicle emissions.
