<p>Having recently moved to the area, particularly because of the semi-rural feel, we are completely devastated to learn of these plans. Owl Lane has an on-going traffic problem, and currently has a traffic survey in place. The volume of vehicles is horrendous with speeding, pollution and noise from illegal exhausts. This is even during the COVID crisis when the traffic has not yet returned to full volume, as at present schools have not yet returned. The cross-roads at Shaw Cross are being resurfaced, forcing all traffic to find alternative routes from 6pm to midnight, from 27/08/20 until 14/09/20. This means the survey is unlikely to record the full volume of traffic, particularly of tea-time, rush hour traffic. Owl Lane has no safe place for pedestrians to cross and is already a danger, without extra vehicles from the proposed 280 houses to be built - alongside the planning application '2020/92331 land east of Leeds Road, Chidswell, Shaw Cross', this would take away the natural landscape and beauty of the whole area, including the wildlife and its habitats.</p>
