| <p>I strongly object to this application - I am appalled that this site was ever included in Kirklees local plan.</p> <p>The local roads and the wider road network are already at breaking point. Heybeck Lane is in reality nothing more than a country lane - the A653 is constantly gridlocked and J28 of the M62 is already over capacity and an area of concern. Cumulative cross border traffic from developments in Wakefield CC and Leeds CC which both border this site has not been fully assessed.</p> <p>Schools - Local schools are already full and even if a primary school is eventually built where do the children go once they reach High School age - Woodkirk year on year is over capacity.</p> <p>Ecology - concreting over huge swathes of green belt land can not possibly result in bio - diversity gains.</p> <p>Mental Health - the benefits of being able to exercise and walk in the countryside on our doorstep should not be underestimated, especially in these unprecedented times.</p> <p>Do what's right - this application needs to be refused - no green fields or green belt land should be sacrificed whilst there are brown field sites and redevelopment land available.</p> <p>Leeds City Council v Aireborough Neighbourhood Development and Mrs Justice Leiven's ruling that all Green Belt Sites in the Leeds Sap are put back in to the Green Belt !</p> |
