There is a serious potential for loss of heritage assets from archeology in the area. Traffic impact assessments conducted during school holidays and lockdown. Loss of area for recreational enjoyment. Traffic onto rural gawthorpe lane, congested a653, m1, m62, owl lane. No provision of amenities..high schools, doctors, dentists etc. Air pollution. Flood risk. Pollution of waterways. This development has catastrophic consequences. The failings in supporting information must be addressed before this moves forward. An extension to the consultation period is essential due to the failings and questions around supporting information currently on the portal.
