<p>I strongly object to this application on the following grounds: Health threats to children from pollution due to thousands of extra vehicle journeys each year using the A653. A huge increase in traffic noise & disturbance. There is a large colony of bats living in the trees & woods, these legally cannot be disturbed, we personally see bats almost every night. I often see a couple of red kite too. The land acts as a zero carbon emission "green lung" separating Kirklees, Wakefield and Leeds. Building on this land will create massive urban sprawl with communities losing their identity. Local schools are operating at capacity with no plans by Kirklees to build new high schools. Doctors' surgeries and public amenities would be unable to cope with such a rise in population, I already find it difficult to get doctors appointments in a reasonable time. The development is contrary to the Government's National Planning Policy Framework which supports health, social and cultural wellbeing. We will have no privacy at the rear of our property, this is the only part of our property where we can sit outside as the front is on the already manic Leeds Road. Our property will devalue as we will lose the views at the rear. My mental & health wellbeing is suffering with all the stress & worry.</p>
