We are aware that planning permission has been sought under the above reference.

We wish to object to the proposed development on former greenbelt land at Chidswell & Heybeck

The loss of green-belt/agricultural land is a real shame – especially when it is going to be built on with little genuine regard for wildlife or their needs to live, forage and thrive.

The Skylark and Yellow Hammer which frequent this site will be evicted from this site as the densely-built environment is utterly unsuitable for them.

Local people have thousands of recording of bat calls in and around the area; and these presence of protected species will be severely damaged if the development goes ahead. If the development goes ahead, it seems more than likely that there will be significant light pollution, which badly affects insect and bat activity.

We strongly oppose this development.
