I am upset to read that the Landowner does not acknowledge that there are bats on this land as I have seen them flying in front of my back bedroom window at dusk since I moved here. In winter its too dark to see them but during the summer months we see them most late evenings.</p> <p>My other worry is the amount of traffic and pollution all the new builds are going to cause. Traffic is extremely busy on a morning and early evening. How much more build up of traffic will be caused with over a thousand new houses many having two cars but businesses and their workers cars?</p> <p>Another worry is our agricultural land. Surely we should now be aiming to be independant in growing crops since the war in Ukrain. The farmers fields are always full and in use why deprive this area of sustaining food especially with the economy as it is.</p> <p>My last point is how is the infrastructure going to manage heath and schooling. I understand a new school and health clinic will be built but if schools and hospitals and primary care are struggling at the moment to find staff this wont get any better in the future. My own NHS dentist now has a four year waiting list for new patients.
