<p>I was introduced to this area by a friend who lives locally. I work as a therapist and have a great love of wildlife and photography. The day I spent in this area totally revitalised me, having worked with people who are suicidal, self harming and generally not coping, all week. I was horrified to hear of this planning application. I urge you to seriously consider what you will be doing to peoples well being who live here. Having seen so much wildlife while I visited, the devastation to local people will be so detrimental to their well being. I hope you can celebrate the wildlife here and be moved to protect them. There are 8 types of bat which are a protected species alongside 3 types of Owls. Red Kite and Common Buzzard, Deer, Foxes and Great Crested Newts to name a few. I managed to photograph a flock of Fieldfare and Redwing. I couldn't believe my eyes when I saw a flock of Grey Partridge (a first) a bird which is Native and Red Listed. I'm finding it hard to believe that all this wildlife will disappear and local children will never experience the wonder that I was privileged to see. The ancient woodland will lose its capacity to be home for many birds and animals as extra pollution and noise will make them homeless. The extra traffic this will create will not benefit the local community. The proposed planning will not support any health, social or cultural well being and will I fear, only create a more anxious and suicidal community.
