This area contains protected ancient woodland and by developing this greenfield site you would be disturbing the native wildlife and their habitat. The extent of the proposals for this site will result in significant and continuous development along Leeds Road A653, thereby merging the settlements of Chidswell, Woodkirk and West Ardsley and the boroughs of Kirklees, Leeds and Wakefield. There as already been a significant number of houses built and being built in the Chidswell area off Owl Lane and also in the Heybeck area with houses being built at Soothill and Haigh Wood.
