

I, _____ wish to make the following comments on the planning application number 2020/92331:

I strongly and actively object to the planning application for over 1300 dwellings being built on this site. The road structure alone in this area can not cope with the extra traffic that this would bring, it is already heavily congested along Leeds Road at all peak times causing long delays

As an _____, I would suffer enormously with the extra atmospheric pollution from the increase in traffic on the roads here, and even more so from dust particles and air pollution caused by the demolition of existing properties and building works and preparations for new ones.

As a family, we walk for miles in the evenings and on weekends in this beautiful, peaceful countryside that is set to be destroyed. This has contributed to the education of our children, in bird watching, wildlife spotting, insect hunting and so much more. For _____ this space provides everything he needs to escape the hustle and bustle, noise and crowded nature of everywhere else we go.

With schools in the local area already at capacity and many even over subscribed, the education of our children is suffering. With no primary school places available in certain year groups already in this area, we have evidence of on going problems that this development will exacerbate further. Provisions within these plans for a two form entry primary school fall far short of what is actually needed and will create more problems when these two forms end primary school at the end of year six with no available spaces in local secondary schools and no proposals to increase provisions.

With medical centres, dental practices and local hospitals all under immense pressure to try to meet the demands of the local population, most are not achieving desired waiting times or government targets. This proposal will only add to demand and push these amenities beyond their capacity and capabilities reducing the quality of care to the local population.

This planned build is on green belt land, which is home to so much wildlife, farm land, woodland and streams. I fear the wildlife population would be devastated if this were to go ahead. The physical and mental wellbeing of the local population would suffer greatly and the local infrastructure and amenities would be overwhelmed. The damage to our countryside is irreversible and would be much better placed elsewhere on brown belt land where it would not destroy natural beauty that should be protected.
