<p>Over a 20 year time scale with dust, light, noise, works traffic for the people who live there.</p> <p>Once it's gone it's gone.</p> <p>Destruction of the wildlife habitats, probable destruction by drying of ancient woodlands. Will Kirklees be responsible for the destruction of woodlands that first appeared in the records in 1300?</p> <p>An extra 22,000 vehicle journeys per day (Church Commissioner's Report) on already choked roads that are already worn out.</p> <p>Plan does not seem to consider the adjoining boroughs because, besides this, we have an estate on the old tip site (KMC), 39 new houses at Shaw Cross (KMC), 288 houses in Owl Lane (KMC) plus all those being built at Haigh Moor (Leeds) and at Soothill Lane (KMC). These are all next to each other and should not be viewed in isolation. Each impacts the other and the residents there.</p> <p>I keep hearing about the Local Plan but a lot has happened since 2019 including the war in Ukraine and the need for increased UK food production.</p> <p>KMC have declared a climate emergency. This development is the wrong size, in the wrong place and at the wrong time.</p>
