I am writing to object to Planning Refs. 2020/92350 & 2020/92331 for the following reasons:-

Owl Lane and Leeds Road are extremely busy and with traffic from 1200 homes, they will become even worse. Whenever there is an accident on the M1 and the M62 those two roads and surrounding roads become jammed now, so heaven help us if the plans are approved.

I understand that the Church of England has refused to have site-specific surveys to assess the quality of the agricultural land.

I understand that the Church of England and Kirklees have ignored comments made by the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust with regard to their findings on the Biodiversity Net Gain report.

I understand that the Church of England has dismissed evidence from the Chidswell Action Group that there is evidence of Schedule 1 species.

I understand that the Church of England has reported no significant bat activity on the site. 9,000 verified recordings of bat calls have been recorded!

To lose such a vast area of agricultural land, hedgerows, streams, trees, and wildlife and replacing with bricks and mortar and roads, is adding to climate change.

How can Kirklees Council be part of the White Rose Forest initiative and still consider these planning applications.
