I object strongly to this application and 106 agreement proposals. It seems to me that following the judicial review judgement to overturn an outline Planning application for the Heybeck site the council feels it can easily satisfy the requirements which were not satisfied previously, and also that this can be done without a full council approval!

It is clear the Planning Department needs to get its act together and consider what the local community require and want!

Over the past years I have seen many infringements of Planning law within this area but apparently Enforcement is not a priority in these instances apparently its more about just ticking boxes for government initiatives rather than looking at the needs of the people. This application needs to be brought before the Strategic Planning Committee. Dum and Dogloitch Ancient Woodlands are not appropriate sites to offset damage caused by the development. They are currently established ancient woodland sites which could not be improved by any proposed diverse scheme!

Currently Kirklees initiatives are to provide a suitable green space locally for all its residents but in this instance they are intent on removing all the local green space of Chidswell and surrounding areas for development turning an urban area in to a over populated new village, in consequence they will not be not providing adequate provision of infrastructure and the needs of such a population for health, education and transport!

Kirklees is such a large area where other development sites would be more appropriate but this council is intent in being led by a land owner whose only interest is in profit and gain!
