<p>I have lived in this area for almost 10 years with the prospect of this matter being considered. I do not believe using greenbelt is the best place to build new homes, there are substantial areas of brownsites in Kirklees that should be considered before using greenbelt. This sentiment has been further bolstered by the recent announcements from Prime Minister Boris Johnson, who has said that greenbelt development should be a very very last resort! Please do not pass this planning application.</p> <p>From a personal point of view I am going to lose my own privacy when in my own home. I will be severley overlooked by a number of properties who will have a direct line of sight into my home; this will have a serious impact on my personal life and my mental health.</p> <p>I also agree with the following matters which may have been considered in all the plans with mitigations but it does not detract from the fact that so many homes is going to have a massive impact on the local infrastructure.</p> <p>Health threats to children from pollution due to thousands of extra vehicles using the A653</p> <p>The land acts as a zero carbon emission "green lung" separating Kirklees, Wakefield and Leeds - building on Chidswell will create massive urban sprawl with communities losing their identity.</p> <p>Local schools are operating at capacity with no plans by Kirklees to build new schools.</p> <p>Doctors' surgeries and public amenities would be unable to cope with such a rise in population.</p> <p>The development is contrary to the Government's National Planning Policy Framework which supports health, social and cultural wellbeing.</p>
