Annex A

Highways England recommend that further assessment is required

HIGHWAYS ENGLAND (“we”) has been appointed by the Secretary of State for Transport as strategic highway company under the provisions of the Infrastructure Act 2015 and is the highway authority, traffic authority and street authority for the Strategic Road Network (SRN). The SRN is a critical national asset and as such we work to ensure that it operates and is managed in the public interest, both in respect of current activities and needs as well as in providing effective stewardship of its long-term operation and integrity.

Highways England recommends that planning consent should not be granted until the assessment and modelling work is finalised to enable both the individual and cross boundary cumulative traffic impact of the development on M62 J28 to be identified and understand what level of mitigation may be required as a result.

Any subsequent mitigation will be subject to a Stage 1 Road Safety Audit prior to Highways England making a formal recommendation. This work is required to ensure the safe and continued operation of the SRN.

We will continue working with the applicant and both Kirklees and Leeds Councils to progress these matters and will review this recommendation no later than 5th August 2021

This response represents our formal recommendations with regard planning application 2020/92350
