I object to this planning application on the following grounds:

1 The fields and woods behind Heybeck Lane provide open green spaces and a habitat for wildlife such as pheasants, hares, squirrels and foxes as well as a recreation area providing clean air. All this would be lost for generations to come.

2 Heybeck Lane Soothill Lane and Leeds Road are busy roads now If this planning application is granted there will be a great increase in the number of vehicles using these roads, adding to greater pollution and a greater risk to the health and safety of adults and children living and working in these areas.

3. Serious consideration must be given to the future - our NHS is under strain, local doctor's surgeries are under pressure and are not taking any more patients, dentists cannot take any more NHS patients either. An increase in the number of proposed dwellings will further increase the pressure on the NHS

4. If this planning application is approved the upheaval caused by the removal of dirt, dust and mud on the roads, and the effect on traffic will be detrimental to residents through the process

5. Finally, as a child of 7 years I have known the view across the fields and taken Girl Guides camping in them and enjoyed the woods.
