<p>I have lived in Crosland Moor for 50 years. My mother worked at Standard Fireworks, as did I and one of my daughters. As such we have lots of connections with the Standard Fireworks Site. I am deeply concerned about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) the volume of houses being built and the impact on road safetyb) the disturbance of both asbestos and gun powder on the site. <p>The last point is the one that concerns me the most. I knew both a former MD and is close friends with the former Head of HR. I have had confirmed that there is asbestos and gunpowder buried on the site. The site was never meant to be built on which is why asbestos etc was allowed (more than likely illegally) to be buried on the site. Also the small sheds used for manufacturing fireworks could never be dismantled for the risk of them exploding due to the volume of dormant gunpowder.</p> <p>In all the years I worked for Standard I was told the land could never be built on. So I'd like to know what has now changed and how will local residents be protected if things go wrong? I recall a blast many, many years ago that blew the windows in of local residents!!!!!!</p>
