I would like to object on numerous points.... 1. Im concerned about the wildlife ie foxes rabbits bats mice and voles etc, building would destroy all. 2. The amount of trees and the wooded areas,i know the planning includes some trees but the loss of mature trees would be much greater. 3. The amount of traffic on Blackmoorfoot Road is very bad now so with another 770 homes each family having approximately 2 cars each that's at least 1500 cars/vans. The 328 bus has to go up on the pavement at busy (especially school times) times as the road isn't wide enough. 4. I understand that there wouldn't be a pavement on both sides of the road from Crosland Hill Road up to Felks Stile Road, which will be bad for pedestrians. 5. Schools, doctors, dentists are all full. The planning does mention a doctors surgery but this isn't compulsory on the application and there is a shortage of gp's. 6. They'll be more concrete and tarmac so where will all the water (rain) go? the drains aren't cleaned out and when it rains they overflow. 7. Another point about public transport, the 328 bus turns down Balmoral Avenue so how will people without a car (especially older people) manage to get another quarter/half a mile or so up to the estate. The 393 mini bus will pass the estate but only carries approximately 20-30 passengers and only runs mon-sat 9-5pm no buses on an evening, bank holidays and sundays.
