<p>This application is ludicrous. The impact on highways needs to be viewed from a top down approach for the wider area and not just local roads.</p> <p>This is not the only large development being proposed in Huddersfield and not the only large development being proposed with a few miles. The development of 250 homes just approved down the road in Netherton for example.</p> <p>The overall impact is thousands of additional cars on roads that are already creaking. Literally and metaphorically. Highways in the local area are limited and traffic will converge in areas already under pressure.</p> <p>The impact of the local plan has been a complete disregard for logic, the current residents and the wider Huddersfield community.</p> <p>The brown field sites and disused buildings within Huddersfield alone are numerous.
