Whilst it is true that the stables are not mentioned in the listing description, the latter were compiled for identification purposes only and the listing certainly extends to them. They also directly abut, indeed overlap, the house and the two form an evocative pairing, both visually and historically.

To that end, we do ask whether the external changes cannot utilise any of the existing openings ? The original door on the ground floor and the two windows on the first all go. This not only diminishes the historic character but will create a patchwork of infilled apertures.

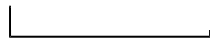
