I wish to submit the following objections and comments in regards to the proposed building of a storage unit at :Land adjacent, former Atlas Quarry Works, Howard Street, Batley, WF17 6AA. Firstly the applicant has cut down a vast amount of trees and dug out land that was once home to . Due to this work already conducted without prior planning permission, it has had an impact on the wild life in the surrounding areas. Further more the land that the applicant wishes to build on is covered in Japanese Knotweed. There has been no mention of how the applicant will safely remove all the knotweed before work is conducted. Moving the knotweed during building would be a great issue for all surrounding homes and businesses. On Howard street during school opening times there is already issues with parking and cars coming up and down the street. This would mean further build up of traffic, loading/unloading during school times will mean further congestion which will become even more dangerous for children that have to cross over to the school building and when leaving. The aesthetics of surrounding buildings are all built with natural stone. The applicants proposed building is to be made of profile steel cladding. This is not keeping in line with the houses in the surrounding area. Behind the proposed property is land that is prone to movement. There does not seem to be any mention of how the applicant will hold up the land above from what he has already been dug out and how he will support the land if he was to continue with digging and construction. If the applicant is to continue there must be something in place to stop movement of the land from the surrounding sides .
