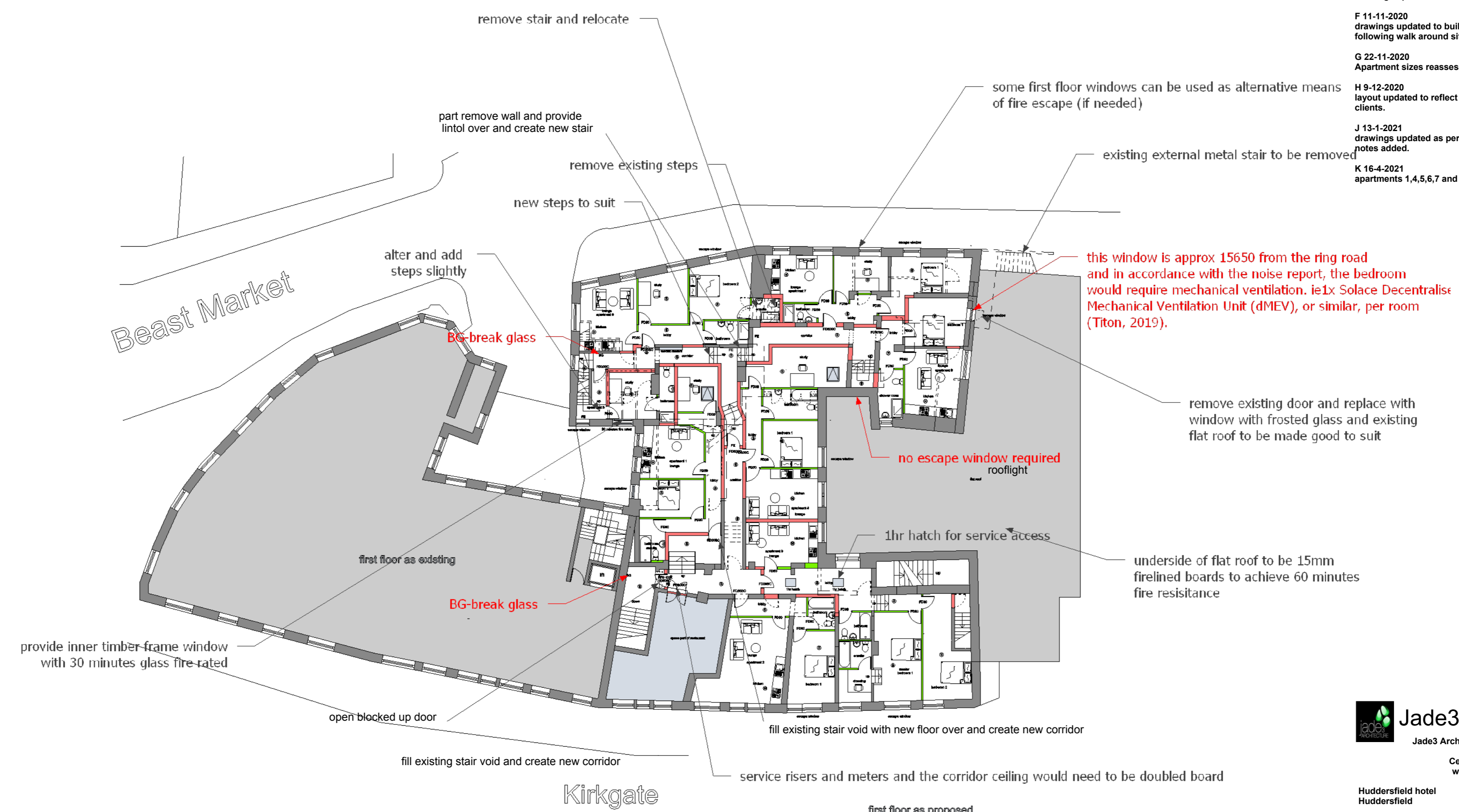

**Note**  
 It has been agreed with building control that since all the first floor has escape windows, there is no need for AOV within the corridors.

The escape window to the attic stair is not required and is now omitted.

the window facing the ring road in apartment 7 is approx 15650 from the ring road and in accordance with the noise report, the bedroom would require mechanical ventilation. ie 1x Solace Decentralised Mechanical Ventilation Unit (dMEV), or similar, per room (Titon, 2019).

1no break glass each added to final exit of both stairs only, no sounders as its a stay put policy.

fire alarm to be linked back to the hotel

fire exit stickers to be provided to the attic rooflights

no external stair needed for fire escape as it is within 4500 high from the external ground level.
