



We were not informed by Kirklees Council that the neighbour had changed the plans and the comment period had reopened. This is very unfair and a complaint has been made. The slight changes we can see after overlaying the amended plan to the original plan, is a very small adjustment, moving the proposed house, further up the incline which will not resolve any issues we have raised previously in our objection. All our concerns still stand.

Our Objection still very much stands.

There has been absolutely no contact from Kirklees planning regarding our invitation to investigate our concerns regarding the serious impact of loss of light to ourselves, noise level, privacy etc.

We ask that you refer to our video again and contact me if you have any questions.

The bats are now circling every early dusk and have Pups this time of year. We watch them every evening congregating around the listed trees that are proposed to be destroyed. They are clearly, landing, flying, hunting and living within the trees. Why on earth has no one contacted us to accept our invitation to observe these protected creatures in their protected trees? where is the bat survey? there isn't one published by Kirklees council available in the public domain. if one exists, it should have been published. This is the law.

Has anyone contacted us about our grave concerns about waste water, flooding, and subsidence? No. Absolutely not.

Has anyone accepted our invitation to visit our garden and actually see the impact this proposed build will have on us and our neighbours? No. Absolutely not.

Has anyone accepted our and our neighbours invitations to observe first hand the flooding and subsidence issues that already exist? No. Absolutely not.

We were not informed that the case officer for this proposal had resigned and a new officer was going to be assigned. We had to ring ourselves to find out this information.

All our invitations still stand. we also invite the newly appointed to this case, planning officer to watch our video on youtube. Objection Church lane.

To reiterate, we Object to this proposal and ask that the planning office reject this plan like they did several years ago BEFORE vicarage meadow was even built.
