The proposed development is not conducive to the surrounding area of natural beauty. The site is not big enough for 57 dwellings. The one entrance/exit and turning circle in the small field will cause far too much noise with the traffic from the new houses using it . Lingards Road cannot support the number of extra cars from the development. . It is a single track at the top that has lots of surface water running down . Which in winter turns to ice. The road leading up from Manchester road adjoins Nields Road which is congested in a morning with school traffic . It has a blind bend further up and turns into a single track road due to other cars parking on it. I believe a planning application was turned down previously for the Church to be turned into a restaurant due to the road not being able to sustain the traffic it would attract . The same goes for this development .it would make the road dangerous. There are not enough schools and doctors to manage the extra residents . I would also be concerned about what the social housing would be being used for and what impact that would have on the existing community . The two storey flats in the small field would take away all privacy for the houses which they overlook. They are also not sympathetic within the existing style of housing there. The outlook at the back is currently very peaceful and a car park and turning circle so close to the houses behind will cause too much noise . Where are the pathways leading out onto Manchester road and alleyways . Will this create rat runs which could attract crime into the area. The top field is used as a footpath for nature lovers and dog walkers . I notice the footpath sign has been removed does this mean the footpath will no longer be there . .
